- I will dress and groom appropriately:

 - Showered, shaved, and looking alert
 - Clean and unwrinkled clothing
- I will follow the policies of De LaSalle Institute.
- I will give 24-hour notice to the De LaSalle Guidance Office if I need to miss tutoring. Failing to do this twice will result in termination as a tutor.

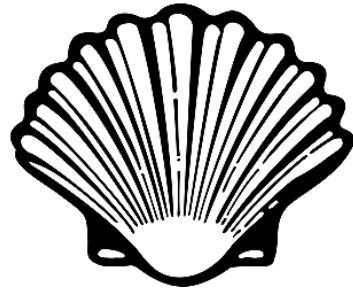

Sundays 10:30-11:30am, at St. James. Classes run September through April. Volunteers must have a background check and go through Virtus training. Begins Sept 20.

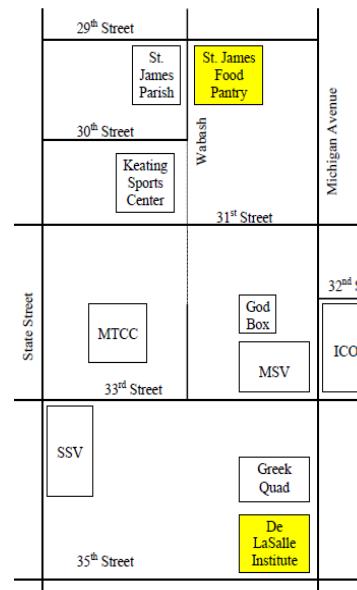


Visiting Seniors
