

#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

#### OF THIS AND THAT...

#### The gift of a new floor

A couple of weeks ago we received a single donation of \$5,000.00 from a parishioner who wishes to remain anonymous. We will, of course, respect the donor's wishes here, and so there will be no note of thanks with the name mentioned. But there has to be a very strong note of thanks, and this is it. With this gift we will be able to put a good and needed finish on the floor of the worship space of our Hall. Months ago, when the vestibule was sanded and finished, many people loved the results and expressed their wish that the whole floor could receive such treatment. Now it will, thanks to one person's generosity.

The work will begin on Monday, December 14. As announced at mass, we will need lots of helpers to move everything out of the main worship space on Sunday afternoon, December 13, in preparation for the work's beginning. So please help out if you can.

#### Year of Mercy—Confessions at St. James

The Jubilee Year of Mercy began this past week with the feast of the Immaculate Conception on December 8. This year will run all the way to November 20, 2016 and we can count on hearing a lot about special events, special prayers, and special celebrations. The goal of all this is to deepen our awareness of God's mercy and our own

all this is to deepen our awareness of God's mercy and our own call to reflect that mercy to all, both inside and outside the Church.

With all these special ways of celebrating God's mercy, we should not neglect the ordinary ways, and among these the sacrament of Confession has pride of place. In nearly all Catholic parishes this sacrament is available on a regular, weekly basis. That has not been the case here at St. James, but with the completion of the Hall we will begin again to offer Confession. Confessions will be heard in the Hall every Saturday, beginning December 19, from 4 to 5 p.m. Our "confessional" will be the vestibule of the Hall, and people will have the option of using a kneeler and a screen, or the face-to-face confession. For this hour, the eastern door will be locked, and people will have to enter by the north door. To enhance privacy, the double doors between the main worship space and the vestibule will be closed, but these doors have glass panes and you will be able to see whether or not someone is in the vestibule having their confession heard.

#### A new evangelization board for a new challenge

As we will be discussing a lot more in the new year, St. James has got to grow. Both Archbishop Cupich and Bishop Perry have made it very clear over the past couple of weeks. Their message is that St. James is *not* facing any immediate threat of closing, but we must start growing if we want to keep it that way. The parish council and the evangelization board will be working on this. If you can help, consider joining the evangelization board, and talk it over with me. Thanks!
