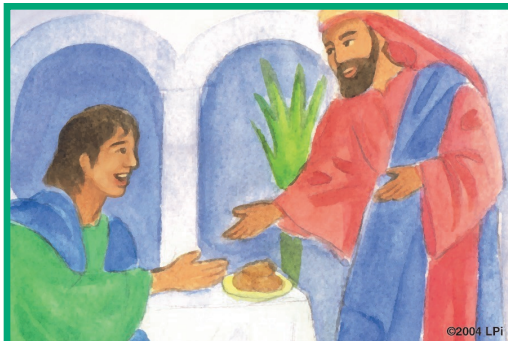

## ON THE WAY....



The rectory of St. James Church (2942 S. Wabash) is the very large home to your pastor. Many parish meetings are held on the first floor in the parlors, the formal dining room and the very large kitchen.

You will also find there our "day chapel," dedicated to Fr. Augustus Tolten, the first African-American Catholic priest in the United States. Daily Mass is held in the chapel Monday through Friday at 7:30am. Recently we started the practice of reciting the Morning Prayer of the Church (the Liturgy of the Hours) at 7:05am.

The second and third floor of the rectory are reserved as residential space for the pastor and other members of his religious community. The Missionary Servants assumed the pastoral care of St. James with the understanding that the rectory could serve as a residence for members of our congregation who are preparing for priesthood and religious life. Let me introduce them.

Brother Gustavo Amell, S.T., is a native of Colombia. He took his first vows as a religious in 2012. He saw the need for missionaries in the United States so he came to begin his theological studies at Seton Hall University in New Jersey. He arrived knowing little English and so had to immerse himself in a new language and culture as well as the study of theology. He will continue his theological education at the Catholic Theological Union (CTU) in Hyde Park as he moves toward his Final Vows and Ordination.

Brother Ramon Flores, S.T., was born in Michoacan, Mexico and moved to the United States as a young boy. He grew up in California and attended school there. After initial formation in Costa Rica and Mexico he took his first vows in 2013. Brother Ramon completed his education in philosophy and began the study of theology at Seton Hall University. He is looking to complete his degree in theology at CTU as final preparation for Final Vows and Ordination.

Brother Victor Manuel Perez, S.T. grew up in Veracruz, Mexico and moved to Alabama as a young man. He worked for several years before feeling the call to religious life and priesthood. The birthplace of the Missionary Servants is in Russell County, Alabama and it was there that he met the congregation. He did formation in Alabama and California and took his first vows on August 7<sup>th</sup> of this year. He needs to complete some requirements in philosophy as preparation for his theological studies. He will attend class at DePaul University as well as CTU this year.

Brother Ernesto Sandoval, S.T. is a native of southern California. The Missionary Servants have served in Compton for many years and Brother Ernesto felt attracted by the charism he saw in the men serving there. He entered formation in Riverside, California and made his novitiate in Holy Trinity, Alabama taking his first vows this August with Brother Victor. He will be attending DePaul and CTU.

Father Domingo Rodriguez, S.T. will be in residence at St. James as he continues his traveling ministry of giving retreats and workshops around the country.

Brother Paul Michalenko, S.T., Director of the Institute of Religious Formation at CTU, will head up the Formation Team as we walk with these men in discerning God's calling in their lives.

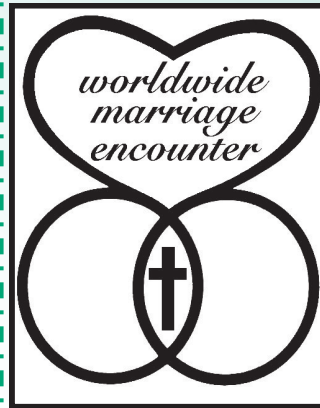
