

Guidelines for in-person attendance at Mass

- Everyone must sign up in advance for Mass.
- We can accommodate a maximum of 37 people at this time (plus volunteers and liturgical ministers) with social distancing of at least six feet. (Members of the same household are exempt from these six-foot social distancing requirements.)
- There remains an inherent risk in coming to church at this time. If you or those for whom you care are vulnerable to infection, we encourage you to stay home and participate in Mass via Zoom.
- If you feel sick in any way, please participate in Mass from your home via Zoom.
- All the faithful of the Archdiocese of Chicago continue to be dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation until further notice.
- We will continue to offer Mass via Zoom. The link for attending Mass on Zoom can be found on our parish website (www.stjameswabash.org) on our calendar or under Mass Times.

At church:

- Wearing a mask is required at all times.
- Please arrive 15 minutes early and enter church through the parking lot entrance where you will be checked in and ushered to a seat.
- Please remain in your seat until you are asked to come forward for Communion.
- A greeter will call you up to receive Communion, and will dismiss you at the end of Mass.
