

ON THE WAY....



May the grace and peace of the Holy Spirit be with us forever.

You know the joke. O. Why is there a Mother's Day and a Father's Day but no Children's Day? A. Every day is children's day. Father's Day was first proposed in a small town in West Virginia in the same year that Mother's Day was celebrated, 1908. It didn't catch on. In 1911 Chicago's Jane Addams suggested a Father's Day holiday but this fizzled out. Father's day as we have it today owes its roots to Spokane, Washington. Sonora Smart Dodd, after hearing a Mother's Day sermon in 1910 suggested to her pastor that it would be fitting to honor fathers as well. (Her father was a Civil War veteran and a single parent who raised six children so she was aware of the contributions of fathers.) The pastors of the Spokane Ministerial Alliance suggested the third Sunday of June. The holiday faded over time because Dodd was not pushing it as she moved to Chicago to study at the Art Institute. In the 1930s, Dodd returned to Spokane and started promoting the celebration again, raising awareness at a national level. She had the help of trade groups that would benefit most from the holiday, for example the manufacturers of ties, tobacco pipes, men's wear and any traditional present to fathers. Several US presidents over the years recognized Father's Day but without any official recognition. It was not until 1966 that President Lyndon B. Johnson issued the first presidential proclamation honoring fathers, designating the third Sunday in June as Father's Day. Six years later, the day was made a permanent national holiday when President Richard Nixon signed it into law in 1972.

While this is not a liturgical feast Father's Day in the United States does give us an opportunity to pause and reflect on the significance of fathers in a child's life. Some chilling statistics: Approximately 18.4 million children live in fatherless households, about 25% of all children. Households without fathers are 4 times more likely to live below the poverty line. About 7 million biological dads are absentee dads to all of their minor children. 85% of youths in prison come from fatherless homes. 71% of high school dropouts come from fatherless homes. According to the U.S. Department of Justice, children from fatherless homes account for 63 percent of youth suicides, 90 percent of all homeless and runaway youths, 85 percent of all children that exhibit behavioral disorders, 70 percent of juveniles in state-operated institutions, 75 percent of adolescent patients in substance abuse centers, 75 percent of rapists motivated by displaced anger. If you ever doubted the importance of fathers those facts should give you pause. Let us first give kudos to those single mothers (and grandparents) who manage to raise healthy and happy children without a father being present. They are truly heroes.

Let us also honor those father-figures – coaches, teachers, mentors, uncles -- who take children under their wing. But at the same time, let us look at social, cultural and economic conditions so that we can help young men to become the fathers they want and need to be. Can a faith which honors God as father do anything less?


